Eight years later, the company's assets were increased by four 650-horsepower ships at 1.820 metric tons, and in two more years, by two other vessels of still greater power and tonnage. In 1865 the Cunard Co., whose mail-carrying charter had just been renewed, successively added to its assets theArabia, the Peria, the China, the Scotia, the Java, and the Russia, all ships of top yeaed and, after the Great Eastern, the biggest ever to plow the seas. So in 1867 this company owned twelve ships, eight with paddle wheels and four with propeller.

On April 13, 1867, with a smooth sea and a moderate breeze, the Scotia lay in longitude 15° 12' and latitude 45° 37'. It was traveling at a speed of 13.43 knots under the thrust of its 1,000-<u>horsepower</u> engines. Its paddle wheels were churning the sea with perfect steadiness. It was then drawing 6.7 meters of water and displacing 6,624 cubic meters.

At 4:17 in the afternoon, during a high tea for passengers gathered in the main lounge, a collision occurred, scarcely noticeable on the whole, affecting the Scotia's hull in that quarter a little astern of its port paddle wheel.
