
In-text assessments motivate students to increase both the volume of reading along with the quality of reading.

LightSail's robust reporting functionality provides extensive data and insights of student progress across more than 150 metrics with customizable date ranges. For administrators and teachers this capability enables data-driven decision making for guided instruction, RTI and, importantly, for accountability regarding a transparent measure of literacy and learning impact.

Useful and customizable dashboards and reports consolidate all high level and discrete data reporting at district, school, class, and student levels. Performance and engagement measures include reading minutes, Lexile growth, and cloze, vocabulary, and comprehension assessments. The reports also track comparative data and the number of books completed. Measures also highlight classes where performance and engagement gaps exist and further support is required.




