LightSail's robust reporting functionality provides extensive data and insights of student progress across more than 150 metrics with customizable date ranges. For administrators and teachers this capability enables data-driven decision making for guided instruction, RTI and, importantly, for accountability regarding a transparent measure of literacy and learning impact.

Useful and customizable dashboards and reports consolidate all high level and discrete data reporting at district, school, class, and student levels. Performance and engagement measures include reading minutes, Lexile growth, and cloze, vocabulary, and comprehension assessments. The reports also track comparative data and the number of books completed. Measures also highlight classes where performance and engagement gaps exist and further support is required.

A student's own snapshot view of key, personal literacy achievement data to empower & encourage student ownership of of personal literacy journey. .

• Personalized Lexile measure timeline and projected Lexile for academic year end • Personalized Reading activity calendar • Personalized grade level skills mastery indicator • Incremental personal reading achievements vs goals



Data Description

- Student own reading minutes vs monthly goal.
- Daily calendar view of student own minutes read, words read and thoughts (annotations) created per day.
- Incremental individual achievements vs goals for texts read, power texts read, Lexile growth.
- Individual Lexile growth over time. Each colored bubble indicates a Lexile measure update and the corresponding measurement period. The student can also see their projected academic year-end Lexile achievent (indicated in grey) based on their current reading and Lexile trajectory.
- Results for multiple choice answers categorized by reading standards.
- Results for short response graded answers categorized by reading standards.

Report Name: Parent Portal Dashboard

Who can view the Report? Parent

LightSail supports including parents in an integral role in their child's literacy growth and development.

The Parent Portal Dashboard is the parent's gateway to observe their child's progress and to assist with the classroom development.



A teacher can initiate an invitation to a parent, or the student can invite their parent from the student dashboard. If a parent accepts, they will observe their child's data highlights, Lexile scores, tips, badges, goals, vocabulary, and assessments. They will also observe all current and past homework assigned by the teacher.
